Meeting called to order by Rick Bosch @ 12:15 pm

Agenda;

Discussion about anyone breaking the rules at the range and depending on the severity of the offence we are to call the RCMP immediately and have the offender removed from the range. Again, depending upon the severity of the offence your membership will also be revoked at that time.

We as Admin of the Range cannot remove anyone from the range!

Then the CFO also has to be phoned and all the particulars of the offence are to be given to them.

The range has now been approved for another 5 years providing we meet all conditions.

We have separate rifle and handgun range, the rifle range is approved for rifle cartridges contained in that template group; 22 long rifle, 223 Remington, 308, 338 lapua. The handgun has been approved for all handgun

cartridges contained in the template group everything goes by template groups.

Template group for this is 22 long riffles, 9mm, 357 Smith & Wesson this covers off from the handgun side every caliber. Pistol range is just pistol only! There is to be no riffles on the pistol bay. All documents will be posted at each range. There is to be no Shotguns on the range at any time as this is against the land owner's rules and the CFO.

Handguns can be used at the riffle side as long as you are behind the firing line!

All range users must be familiar with the range operating procedures.

We will be reviewing the new SOR when it becomes available the end of January.

We are purposing today and will be tabled for the AGM in the March is to give the out of towners voting rights & take 2 out of towners on the board of directors.

There will be changes to the range as far as the layout of targets and to color code each bench with its corresponding targets to eliminate any chance of cross firing.

Ammunition clarification; Steal core ammunition falls into the template of penetrator tungsten carbide will not be allowed to be shot at our range.

If the range is to be rented for a floating firing line certain conditions apply, the range must be rented, documents must be submitted to the board for approval of what is taking place, how many people are attending. The range must be closed to all members and one of the board members from DDSA must attend this event and everyone must keep to the rules of the range including having a range officer and safety officer. Fees do apply for these special events of \$500.00

Templates for all calibers will be laminated and posted at each range.

Our new project proposals for the 2018 year is to general cleanup of the entrance and driveway to the parking area at the range, Rifle bay will get a new cover that will cover over the c-can and the firing benches, Re-align the rifle targets from left to right will be 25-50-75-100-200-300.targets these will have a proper head shot and heart shot. A culvert will be put in at the 300. Put in proper steal gongs at 100-200-300. The barrier between the rifle range and the handgun range needs to be fixed. Wheelchair access will be put in at both ranges.We are proposing a new pistol bay in the west corner of the range. This proposal will have to meet the CFO and the Landowners requirements. An estimate of \$15,000 for the new pistol range.We are looking at bringing in another 100 members for this expansion. We are also looking into a government grant for the wheelchair access.

A proposal will be brought up at the next AGM in regards to what we will do for those that volunteer their time and equipment that will be used for further work b's. With your memberships to our range you are automatically covered under CSSA Insurance policy.

We are proposing a new membership rate of \$180.00 for a standard membership rate, \$20 per person extra for family and \$80.00 for Senior guest fee of \$10.00 will remain the same.

Kevin Allenback motioned to increase our membership fee of \$180.00
Second by Fred Makowecki All in favor by show of hands.

Yearly lead remediation needs to be done, as per the agreement with the land owner.

The rules are not the rules of the DDSA, these rules are from the CFO and enforced by the board members of the range.

At the AGM, the local members will vote on excepting all out of towners to be able to vote.
